“The Weapon of Courage”

Christ commands us to confront our fear and to be free from its tyranny. God places the weapon of courage before us as our first skill in overcoming fear.

Courage sometimes floats like a vague concept in our minds because we watch television programs which show heroes who seem fearless. I think we can develop courage by practicing three daily habits:

Purpose – When we understand our *life* purpose, courage flows from the demands of our *God-given* purpose.

Patience – Never believe that courage means an insane charge against an overwhelming enemy. Often courage expresses itself in patient learning, team building and timing.

Persistence – The daily commitment to do the next right thing; solve the next problem and overcome the next challenge. These habits express courage and turn every day into a step toward our ultimate goal.

Christ commands us to be courageous, not afraid. His order implies the following: live for a purpose, live with an anticipating patience, and live persistently.

Now may Jesus Christ himself inspire you with courage and fill you with grace to overcome every fear.
