WHAT EVERY PARENT NEEDS TO KNOW...

All children attending Mission Adventure must be registered in the program. Registration forms are available at the Guest Services table in each ministry area.

To maximize safety and security, strict drop-off and pick-up policies are enforced. Safety and security policies for each ministry area are outlined on the following page.

Parent's please note: If your children have any allergies or special dietary needs and cannot eat what we have provided, please inform the teachers **each time** you drop your child off.

In order to promote health and wellness in all children, our programming is intended for well children only. Therefore, if a child has any of the following symptoms within the past 24 hours, please do not admit him/her to Mission Adventure.

- Any degree of fever
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Unexplained or contagious skin rash
- Chronic cough
- Runny nose (yellow/green discharge)
- Eye/ Ear infections
- Parasites (nits, lice, mites, ring worm, etc.)
- Unusual fatigue or irritability

If your child attends **Mini-Venture** or **Play-Venture**, please also make note of the following:

If your child is potty training, please be sure to let the teacher know. While we do have some spare clothing items, you may want to bring an extra change of clothes.

Volunteers are trained to provide the minimal assistance necessary and preferably without entering the restroom with your child. We do ask that men serving in the ministry refrain from diaper changing and from providing any bathroom assistance.

Goldfish and Cheerios are generally provided during snack time in Mini-Venture and Play-Venture ministries. If we are serving something else that week, it will be posted outside the classroom.

Do not bring toys from home, as it is very difficult to keep up with them and it causes unnecessary stress for the kids when they are asked to share with other children.

Please label all items that belong to your children.
